

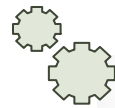
So How does it Work?

First, You Apply



An application should be in writing, and should explain the reason for the application, and how much money is being requested. This doesn't need to be long and formal - a few paragraphs will do. Give the application to one of the clergy or a PCC member.

Second, PCC will Discuss and Decide



During their monthly meeting, the Vicar and PCC will decide on each application, bearing in mind these factors:

- Is there enough money in the fund?
- Are we already supporting something similar, and if so, what is special about this application?
- Is the application for a good cause that matches the PCC main purpose? (See below.)



The Main Purpose of the PCC

“to co-operate with the minister in promoting in the parish the whole mission of the Church, pastoral, evangelistic, social and ecumenical.”

Third, PCC will reply

The PCC will reply, and may offer all or part of the requested amount.

Sometimes, the PCC may suggest that you re-apply later in the year.

If you wish, your application can be treated as confidential, and your name will not be used.

You can apply for yourself, or on behalf of a friend or neighbour.

The success of an application can be affected by what other applications have already been granted. If so, you may be asked to apply again later.
